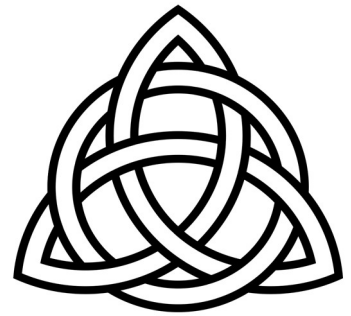


# HOLSWORTHY MISSION COMMUNITY NEWS
